The TLI30321 Certificate III in Supply Chain Operations reflects the role of individuals engaged in supply chain operations and includes specialisations for logistics and warehousing operations. It involves a defined range of skilled operations, usually within a range of broader related activities involving known routines, methods and procedures, where some discretion and judgement is required in selecting equipment, services or contingency measures within known time constraints. It may also include responsibility for coordinating the work of others.
